<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Belts 2. Shoelaces 3. Do-rags 4. Scarves 5. Bag straps 6. Hats or unapproved headwear 7. Knee-high socks 8. Nylons/pantyhose 9. Strings 10. Tops: crop tops, off the shoulder tops, sheer tops 11. Excessively ripped jeans 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Personal undergarments 2. Clean Clothing: t-shirts, sweat pants, leggings, jeans, sweatshirts (no hoods), pajamas (<i>3 days' worth</i>) 3. Tank tops: camisoles, tank tops, spaghetti straps must be worn underneath clothing. 4. Shorts: shorts, skirts, and dresses must be long enough that they reach the same point on the thigh as the bottom of the finger tips when the arm is extended and resting on the thigh. Items should fully cover undergarments. 5. Shoes/Socks: slip on sneakers, slides, and crocs are recommended. Non-skid socks are preferred. 6. Jewelry: jewelry of high value should be sent home due to the risk of losing or misplacing items. 7. Religious garb and grooming practices permitted 8. Miscellaneous: Other headwear permitted with medical exemption (please consult with charge nurse/clinical team).
